

BUS STOP SAFETY

"Stress Safety to Kids at School Bus Stops"

Here are tips from the Clark County Transportation Department to keep children safe at school bus stops:

- Arrive at the bus stop 5 minutes before arrival of bus.
- Make sure your child stands at least 10 feet (five giant steps) from the road while waiting.
- Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before boarding and exiting.
- Take a seat right away and remain seated facing forward.
- Secure all belongings in a zipped backpack.
- Wear bright, contrasting clothing colors.
- When exiting the bus, look to the left and right.
- NEVER walk behind the bus.
