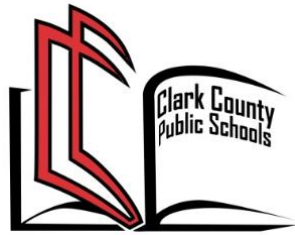

Good Afternoon Clark County Schools Staff and Families:

I, along with most of you, had high hopes of returning to in-person instruction as we begin the New Year. However, due to the recent increase in COVID-19 cases in our community in general, Clark County Public Schools will remain in all virtual instruction through the first half of the nine weeks, with a plan to resume in-person instruction on February 22, 2021, if the infection rate numbers permit. We will continue to monitor the local infection rate daily. A decision regarding the return to in-person instruction will be made during the week of February 15.

All staff will continue to report to their regular work locations during this time. Any requests for alternate accommodations for staff must be approved through the building principal and the superintendent. We will continue to work with our local health department and staff to assess what is best for the safety of all staff members, students, and the community.

Our bus stop meal delivery service will continue during this time of virtual instruction. Please continue to refer to the Clark County Public Schools websites and social media accounts for any updates or school activity changes.
