Safety/Logistics Subcommittee Minutes

July 01, 2020

- Governor plans to create and forward guidance documents to school system. Documents will reflect CDC and Health Department directives.
- School system is planning on creating and disseminating surveys to parents and staff to attempt to solicit input into educational models/and/or plans to implement upon the return to school.
- Parks and Rec closed city and county parks
- August 31st waivers end.
- Schools have been closed down and staff badges suspended until further notice. Staff must go through principal to gain access to buildings during summer.
- No summer school
- Work from home initiative still in force to extent possible
- PPE will need to be ordered asap, in large quantities to accommodate the return to school in August. PPE will need to include masks, gloves, barriers, and gowns.
- Social Distancing will be extremely challenging in the school setting, especially during transitions.
- Food Services has taken large hits in funding and expenses throughout summer. Concerns with children getting fed during the summer months.
- Food Services staff are at great risk of contracting the virus, given their exposure to families during food transfers.
- Food cannot be prepared in school kitchens, must provide cold packed lunches to families.
- Students may need to be fed in classrooms
- Transportation of students will be near impossible for social distancing given a finite number of buses and drivers without some concessions from the state.
- Sanitizing buses between runs will be a need. Shuttling students from GRC to Campbell will need significant planning.
