Clark County Public Schools' Staff and Families:

Based on recommendations by the Kentucky Department of Education and state and local health departments, Clark County Public Schools will remain in all virtual instruction through **Friday, January 8**. Our Bus Stop Meal Delivery service will continue during the week of January 4-8. On **Thursday, January 7**, a decision will be made regarding whether we may return to in-person instruction on **Monday, January 11**.

The expectation is that all staff report to their regular work locations beginning **Monday, January 4**. Throughout the 2nd semester, in the case of district-declared inclement weather, an "NTI Day" will be announced, and teachers and staff should be prepared to deliver instruction virtually from their homes to their students, as there will be no "Snow Days" this school year.

We will continue to work with our local health department using COVID-19 daily updates regarding Clark County's current status to assess what is best for the safety of all stakeholders. Stopping the increase of local cases and providing our students with in-person instruction will require all of us working together as a community. Refer to Clark County Public Schools' websites and social media accounts for updates and current school activity changes.
