1. Christy Bush welcomed the attendees at 11:30. See sign in sheet for those in attendance.
2. An Introduction was made to introduce Kristi Carter as the new FRC person for Shearer Elementary.
3. There has been a link added to the main Clark County Public Schools website, it is under Departments>Student Support Services/Attendance/DPP. The DPP webpage is an informational page that gives the email and phone number for Student Support Services throughout the district.
4. Lunch was provided from Gaunces.
5. Jennifer Winburn discussed the new OLR (online registration) and the new Yellow Folder system that will take the place of cumulative folders in the future. OLR is only for new students to the district at this point.
6. Judge's recommendation of "rebranding" the FRC's in the schools. After a discussion with the FRC personnel it was determined they would do a pamphlet that listed all of the available resources that the FRC provides. FRC services are available to all students.
7. Brainstorming if students do not come back to school in person. Christy Bush asked that they think about what each month would like for them and how they can be available to help families in need. One suggestion was to have "office hours" where families could come in and meet with FRC, nurse, counselor, teacher etc. Partnering with the nurse and counselors on ways to help families.
8. Food Service Director Becky Lowery discussed the options for the 20-21 school year. Our waivers end August 30, 2020. The waivers come from Federal not State government. She is hoping the plan stays the same for the fall as it was in the spring. Possibility of home delivery of food if the county as a whole does distance learning, this would require a permission slip from the parent. They would need help getting the permission slips back if it comes to that.
9. FRC staff and Christy Bush discussed different options for ReadiFest that is scheduled for August 28, 2020. Concerns about traffic flow was the top discussion.
