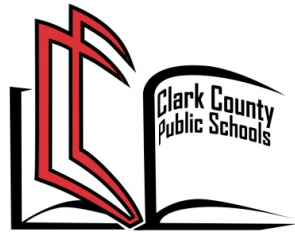

Dear Clark County Families:

Clark County Public Schools is committed to continuing to offer the highest level of service to your student(s) as we bring students back to school for in-person learning while also continuing to offer distance learning for those who prefer that model.



The Foodservice Department will offer breakfast and lunch daily to all children ages 18 and under FREE of charge.

What to expect... Starting October 30, 2020:

Students attending in-person learning will be offered breakfast and lunch daily while in school.

In addition:

- Group A will receive a breakfast and lunch on Tuesdays at the end of the school day for Wednesday. Group A will need to pick up meals on Thursdays and Fridays. Friday's pickup will also include meals for Saturday.
- Group B will need to pick up meals on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays. Group B will receive a breakfast and lunch on Friday at the end of the school day for Saturday.

Students participating in distance learning can pick up breakfast and lunch Mondays through Fridays at the school of their choice.

Information about the meal pick-up process:

- Please pick up at one site only. This allows us to ensure all Clark County children have access to free meals.
- Meals may be picked up from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM.
- A designated adult or the student may pick up the meals. The student does not have to be present for the designated adult to pick up meals.
- If the parent/guardian has students that attend different schools, meals may be picked up at any one school location.

Your participation in this program is greatly appreciated. We rely on the participation of all students to allow our program to thrive. Foodservice is dependent upon federal funding which is directly linked to the number of meals served. Your participation does not deprive other families in need, it ensures that we can continue to serve ALL students across the district.
