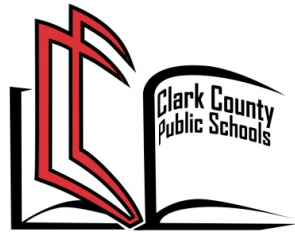

Dear Clark County Families,

Clark County Schools is committed to continuing to offer the highest level of service to your student(s) as we start the 2020-2021 school year virtually. The Foodservice Department and Transportation Department are collaborating to deliver breakfast and lunch daily.



Anyone 18 years and younger is eligible to begin receiving meals on September 8, 2020.

What to expect:

- A designated adult or child must come to the bus stop to receive the meals.
- In order to minimize food waste, your student will be removed from the list after three (3) unsuccessful attempts to deliver meals to the address provided by the parent/guardian.
- We anticipate the buses will deliver meals between 10:30 am and 1:30 pm Monday through Friday. You will receive a phone call or email from the Transportation Department letting you know the bus number and time the bus should arrive at your student(s) bus stop.
