Back to School Plan 2021-2022

Our goal is to maintain a safe and successful school year through in-person learning. The following guidelines may be adjusted based on additional federal and state mandates and/or local health department guidance.

1. Social Distancing

Social distancing of 3 feet will occur when possible. Visitors to schools may be limited. Transitions may be modified or reduced based on schedules and safety needs. Each school will be responsible for communicating specific requirements.



2. Masks/Ventilation



At this time, masks are recommended while in our buildings. Mask ARE REQUIRED in our ATC school per state requirements. Outdoor spaces will be utilized when possible. Air Filtration systems have been upgraded and filters are replaced more frequently than recommended.

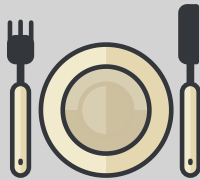
3. Transportation

Masks will be worn by all staff and students while on the bus. An antimicrobial will be applied to surfaces. Students will ride in assigned seats and be grouped by household.



4. Food Service

Students will be delivered breakfast in their classrooms. At this point, students will be eating a traditional lunch in the cafeteria. Students participating in the Cardinal Alternative Option will have meal pick up available on weekly basis.



5. Screening Protocols and Responses

A temperature greater than 100.6 will result in being sent home. Symptomatic students will be isolated from others. A student or staff member sent home with COVID-19 symptoms will be able to return to school after meeting the requirements set by our local health department based on vaccination status or quarantine guidelines. Parents will ensure daily temperature and symptom checks. Contact tracing will follow CCHD guidelines.



6. Sanitation & Safety

Staff members will treat surfaces throughout buildings with an approved antimicrobial. Hand sanitizer will be available in every classroom, and students will be expected to use it as they enter and leave classrooms. Staff will teach and reinforce proper handwashing and our custodial staff will continue cleaning higher standards and frequency.
